Bring school leaders, law enforcement, fire/EMS, and emergency management into the same room, on the same plan

WHAT SSAVEIM TRAIN-THE-TRAINER DOES

- 16-hour course for 9 trainer candidates (3 law enforcement, 3 fire/EMS, 3 school staff)
- Day 1: Your trainers learn the curriculum, exercises, and system
- Day 2: They run an 8-hour course for up to 40 participants to prove they can deliver it
- You keep the curriculum, ASIM Checklists, reunification tools†, and LMS access so you can repeat training annually or more

Result: one team, one school incident plan, trained and documented.
